A specialised ingredient blend intended for use in endurance-focused functional beverage recipes. With Cordyceps, Rhodiola Rosea, Panax Ginseng, Vitamin B12, and Magnesium Citrate, ENERON-B delivers the ingredients commonly sought in products positioned for enhanced endurance, reduced fatigue, and support for heart and muscle health.

Functional Focus

A dry, powdered functional blend designed to support stamina and physical performance. Cordyceps, rhodiola, and ginseng are widely used in endurance and resilience-focused formulations, while magnesium supports muscle function and electrolyte balance. Vitamin B12 contributes to normal energy metabolism and helps reduce tiredness and fatigue.

Product Use

ENERON-B is designed for versatility across a wide range of beverage applications. This blend has a slight herbal flavour profile, allowing it to integrate easily into functional drink formulations based on fruit juices and juice drinks, smoothies, flavoured carbonated beverages, sports drinks, teas, coffees, and low to no alcohol beverages. The blend dissolves readily in water and confers a light, copper-brown hue to beverages.

pH Tolerance: Recommended final product pH of ~3.6-4.5 for optimum stability of bioactive compounds.

Pasteurization: The blend is compatible with typical beverage pasteurization processes. The heating process may affect the bioactive compounds within product; however, extent is variable depending on methodology.

Blending method: Product should be added pre-carbonation to avoid foaming. To maintain quality of bioactive compounds, adding post-fermentation, pre-carbonation and pasteurization is preferred. However, can be added hot side if pasteurization is not available.

ENERON-B is supplied in 0.5, 1.125, or 3.0kg HDPE tubs. Containers meet all food industry packaging regulations

Storage
