FUNCTIONAL BEVERAGE POWDER BLEND

A specialist ingredient blend intended for use in electrolyte-focused functional beverage recipes. With Sodium Chloride, Potassium Citrate, Magnesium Citrate, and Calcium Lactate, PERFORMAL-C delivers the ingredients commonly sought in products positioned for hydration, electrolyte replenishment, and fluid balance.

Functional Focus

A dry, powdered functional blend designed for use in hydration-oriented beverage formulations. PERFORMAL-C provides a multi-mineral electrolyte system delivering sodium, potassium, magnesium, and calcium, electrolytes commonly used to support fluid balance. Magnesium contributes to normal muscle function, supporting use in active lifestyle and hydration products.

Product Use

PERFORMAL-C is designed for versatility across a wide range of beverage applications. This blend has a slightly salty flavour profile, allowing it to integrate easily into functional drink formulations based on fruit juices and juice drinks, smoothies, flavoured carbonated beverages, sports drinks, and flavoured waters. PERFORMAL-C dissolves readily in water and has minimal colour impact.

pH Tolerance: Recommended final product pH of ~3.5-4.2 for optimum stability of bioactive ions.

Pasteurization: The blend is compatible with typical beverage pasteurization processes. The heating process may affect the bioactive compounds within product; however, extent is variable depending on methodology.



Blending: Product should be added pre-carbonation to avoid foaming. To maintain quality of bioactive compounds, adding post-fermentation, pre-carbonation and pasteurization is preferred. However, can be added hot side if pasteurization is not available.

PERFORMAL-C is supplied in 0.5, 1.125, or 3.0kg HDPE tubs. Containers meet all food industry packaging regulations.

Storage
